Northern Dynasty says that it won't harm the land. They also told us that they wouldn't use cyanide. But they told New York security analysts that they intend to — right at the headwaters of the Kaktuli and the Upper Talarik.

They told us that the pit mine will “only” be about 3 miles long, 1 1/2 miles wide, and a 1/4 mile deep. But they and other companies have staked claims over 1,000 square miles of wilderness where our fish spawn, our caribou, moose and bears roam — and where we hunt and fish. In November, the village of Nondalton took 14 caribou right where Pebble Mine will sit.
