



Your immediate action is needed to help stop the state from **turning Alaska rivers into killing zones.**

The Murkowski administration has proposed allowing pollution in salmon spawning streams, which Alaska law currently prohibits. The creation of these "Mixing Zones" would let mining companies discharge pollution above the levels currently in place to protect fish. Low levels of pollutants can kill fish eggs and smolts. And if you eat large amounts of fish, toxic chemicals can accumulate in your body.

Let the State of Alaska know that you don't want mixing zones in Bristol Bay streams and rivers.
